Movie Nights

A great fundraiser if you can find a cinema or school or church which will donate the facilities and equipment. Some Cinemas do rent out facilities for birthday parties and might make an exception and donate one show as a charitable contribution. Ask them if a percentage from the popcorn/soda/candy sales can also be donated. If your working with a smaller setting like a big screen TV and DVD player you may want to setup to sell popcorn, candy, cokes..etc. Local merchants might donate to help cover cost of these items or parents volunteer to bring certain things.

First, decide on the type of movie – should it be a family movie in an attempt to attract families with young children; should it be an action/drama film which might attract an older age group. In some cases you may be able to do both if separate rooms are available. Mom and Dad would watch a nice action or drama while at the same time their children are watching something appropriate in the next room. This would take someone overseeing the children to be sure all is well with them. Make sure to let it be known that the funds raised are going to be used to help feed and educate the children of the GSCH.

Then pick an evening, a popular movie, and advertise. These would be great youth or children's activities.
