When we heard that our oldest daughter, Mirian was going to go translate with a team in Oropoli Eva told her the how God used that village to bring us to Honduras and to please look for Ana, Lupe and Maria.

One big question that had been on Ana's heart was if God had ever given us children, had now been answered. As Mirian told her of the GSCH and all the children God had given, Ana could only say "Praise God!! Praise God!"

A few weeks later Ana, Lupe and Maria arrived at the gates of the GSCH to see us. After the tears and joy of seeing each other they were amazed to see what God had done.

All three are Christians, married and have children. Ana married a good Christian man and has been teaching Sunday school since we left. Lupe and Maria are also married with children and help Ana with the Sunday school classes. Pray for their husbands who still have not accepted Christ.

Our normal personal monthly donations continue to run low and for the last 3 or 4 months have been as low as 50% of what is needed to meet our obligations to support our family.

Education! Statistics show that lack of education is a major contributor of poverty. Poverty is the major contributor to alcoholism and abuse. Without funding we can not educate the children which means they will return to poverty when they leave the GSCH. Education is not optional.

The Good Shepherd Christian School needs your help. We are asking God to raise up 200 sponsors to provide \$50 monthly for our children to have a solid Christian education. 200 - 4 = 196 more sponsors needed.

Wash cycles take a whole new meaning...

When you must use two washing machines to finish one load of clothes. One washing machine washes but will not spin so clothes are moved from the wash machine to the spin machine. Most of our clothes are hand washed but add on top of that towels and sheets for 230 + persons. We are weighing options of a commercial washing machine, around \$3300 or 7 normal household heavy duty size at \$500 to \$550 each. Pray for the funds come in and we make the right choice.
